Scholarship Application Instructions

PURPOSE:

To recognize and support an OKVMA member or immediate family member, as an outstanding undergraduate or graduate studying at an Oklahoma college or university. OKVMA will be awarding scholarships for the 2020-2021.

RECOGNITION TO BE AWARDED:

The scholarship recipients will be selected by a committee of OKVMA members, appointed by the President, and will receive the following:

*A certificate commemorating the award

- * \$1000 scholarship
- * Invitation to attend the Annual Fall Conference

ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant must be an OKVMA member or immediate family member. The applicant must also be enrolled in an accredited Oklahoma college or university and be classified as a freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student. The applicant must maintain active enrollment and full-time status.

SELECTION CRITERIA ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Complete Application (5%)

Application Form -- Official Transcripts - Resume -- 3 Reference Letters -- Written Summary

Scholarship (40%)

Diversity and difficulty of course work taken, grade point average, significant academic honors, awards and achievements, and membership organizations and/or honor societies.

Leadership and Extracurricular Activities (20%)

Participation in recognized clubs and organizations, elected offices, committees, projects and honors/awards for leadership and extracurricular activities.

Personal Traits (20%)

Evidence of good personal traits such as character, ethics, communication skills, dependability, innovation and a strong work ethic. A particular emphasis will be placed on communication skills. The applicant should include information about work experience, honors, awards and/or activities that reflect personal traits. Three letters of personal reference from employers, professors or academic advisors must be included.

Written Summary (15%)

Written summary should address the selection criteria, applicant's personal - work - educational background, objective of your educational program and career plans.

Application Deadline: July 17, 2020

The completed application form, accompanied with official transcript(s), brief resume that addresses the selection criteria, 3 one-page letters of references, and written summary must be submitted to the below address by July 17, 2020.
